

BEADED BINDINGS AND FRINGES

Class Supply List

Small sample quilt meeting the following requirements:

Straight edges

Bound with straight of grain binding

Minimum size 12" x 12"

Beading needles, size 10 or 12 (I prefer John James or Pony brand)

Nymo® thread, size D, to match color of quilt binding (available in bead shops or online)

Thread Heaven Thread Conditioner & Protectant

Variety of Seed beads, size 8 and/or 6 in colors that complement your quilt

Variety of Bugle beads, size 3, about 1/4" long in colors that complement your quilt

Piece of foam "blanket" or low-sided dish to hold beads for easy pickup

Scissors to clip threads

Straight pins

Ruler

Task light (optional but recommended)

NOTE: This is a technique, rather than a project, class. You will have the opportunity to learn and try various beading patterns to use on future projects.

It is vital that your sample quilt be ready for class. Use an orphan block or simply layer a piece of fabric and finish with simple grid or channel quilting on your machine. You may bind the quilt with your favorite method; just make sure that you use ***straight of grain*** binding.
